This is the Pisa crest which was created in 1242. In that time the town of Pisa was one of the most powerful maritime republic .



In fact the red in its crest represent the loyalty to Federico Barbarossa who wanted Pisa as an ally to his empire.

Where is Pisa located?

Pisa is located in Tuscany, Italy, near the coast and the city of Florence

MARINA DI PISA: what is it?



Marina di Pisa is a village located on the coast near the town of Pisa. It didn't exist before 1606 because it was a marshy area which it was reclaimed in that year.

For that reason there is one street alongside the sea which the right side is full of beach clubs and bars and the left side is full of houses and restaurants where people can relax and refresh themselves

Miracles square has been one of the human race's heritages since 1987

Miracles square was built in 1063 with Carrara marble, but it had already existed since Middle Ages and the Romans' era. The name "Miracles square" refers to the fact that in this square there are four of the most important religious building of Europe: the Cathedral, the Baptistery, the Holy Field and the Leaning Tower which was meant to be the bell tower of the Cathedral

Something about Corso Italia street!



Corso Italia is the main shopping street of Pisa. Its distinctive trait is that Corso Italia is a totally pedestrian street and there is a mixture of bars, clothes and makeup shops (the most famous are H&M, Shepora and Tally Weil), jewelry stores (like Pandora) and restaurants where you can go shopping or you can simply have a nice walk



The education system of Pisa: how it is



Pisa was the first city of Italy to discover the Internet because the research center CNUCE took part with its most brilliant IT engineers to the American Military project called ARPANET

The education system of Pisa is one of the most renowned in Europe.
